TNF NEEDS YOU!

JEF-Europe (www.jef.eu) is issuing a call for the post of the Editor in-Chief and members of the Editorial Board for its by-yearly paper magazine “The New Federalist” (TNF) and its on-line edition **thenewfederalist.eu**, which forms part of the broader *Taurillon* webzine as its English version.

The New Federalist is a publication of the Young European Federalists (JEF-Europe) issued twice per year, normally in spring and autumn. If the funding permits, more editions are possible. Thus the work-load for the paper version is high only on two occasions. However, the Editor-in-Chief and his/her team are simultaneously responsible also for the online version (www.thenewfederalist.eu), which needs daily or at least weekly attention, given the current momentum of a new article being published every 3-5 days.

Thus the Editor-in-chief should be a highly motivated, fluent in English-with special interest in journalism-team-player and will be expected to form, organise and coordinate the “TNF-team”.

The main tasks of this position include the designing of the magazine’s content, the collection of articles, the coordination of the editorial team, fundraising and advertising activities and the promotion of the magazine internally and externally.

If you enjoy writing and want to prove your editorial skills through the great experience of being Editor-in-Chief, a member of the Editorial Board or simply a contributor to a pan-European magazine, let us know!

Requirements & Deadline

- Those interested in the post of Editor-in-Chief (*the Federal Committee of JEF-Europe will elect this post at its spring meeting in Switzerland at the end of March*) should:
 - have a certain degree of experience in journalistic work
 - have excellent English skills
 - have certain knowledge and experience with project management
 - be flexible and prepared to work on a voluntary, yet committed basis.
